TRAINING OVERNIGHT CAMP



BALOO training is the Cub Scout leader training required for any Cub Scout den or pack outdoor event, including pack camping overnights and Webelos den overnights.

Prerequisite: BALOO training is comprised of two components—an online component and a practical, hands-on component. Both components must be completed to qualify as a “TRAINED” Cub Scout outdoor leader. **The online component must be completed prior to the practical component.** The online training contains introductory and basic information that will be built upon during the practical training.
